USA MINISTRY REVIVED

After 4 years of covid restrictions and many of our staff being unable to travel into the USA, we were thrilled at the announcement of all restrictions being dropped in May, and immediately began to pack our bags! What followed was a six-week ministry trip to the USA, specifically to re-establish Creation Research in the States, and to encourage our long-term American supporters.

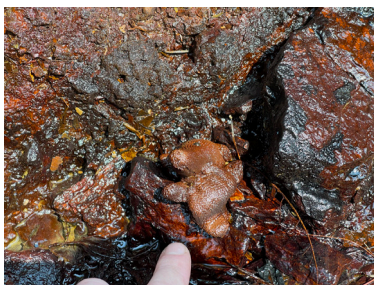
We spent a whole week in Jamestown, Tennessee, with Creation Research USA rep Glenn Wilson and his Church, which included radio programs every day, and three teaching sessions throughout the week. Catch up on the

Great research abounded, including two new sites explored, with evidence of rapid fossilisation present throughout. The waterfall that came cascading down through the geology, mixed with a mass of rotting vegetation (providing the biological element necessary), ended up depositing vast amounts of iron carbonate in

a layered deposit. Process, not time for sure – and a fast process at that. This is easily proven by the fact that the road cut is well under 100 years old, and Creation Researcher Glenn Wilson performed an experiment with Wade Delk. They placed a number of soft items under the running water, including a covid-mask, a shoelace, and a cuddly elephant toy. When Joe Hubbard visited less than three months later, most of the items had fully permineralised – they were literally hard as rock! Minerals from the deposit had permeated the soft tissue of the toy, entrapping it in hard rock. Note well; it is this same process that preserves other fossils like dinosaur bones. Process – not time for sure, and no millions of years in sight!

A great year of research and field trip discoveries so far, as we spent a week with homeschoolers, youth groups and Easter Sunday services, as well as a visit to Aust Cliff (Bristol) for the 'Dragons Under the Bridge' field trip! Finds included a

fabulous fossil footprint, along with polystrate pecten shells (living fossils) and giant coprolite (fossil poop!). Most unusual find went to Donovan, who discovered recent roadworks had diverted a creek over the cliff edge, through topsoil and plant mulch, and through a local exposure of Jurassic limestone. The result? A huge calcium carbonate stalactite-like deposit at the top of the cliffs. It certainly wasn't there in 2018 when John Mackay and Joe Hubbard last visited, so this entire deposit is less than 3 years old. One rather sizable chunk had fallen off revealing a large tuffa-like deposit full of modern fossils - leaves, branches,

etc, caught up in the crystals. This was collected for our UK museum, where it will be added to our 'Tites 'n' Mites' display, which also includes our new stalactite machine. Creation Research has long championed the reality that stalactite/calcium carbonate/limestone formation is not an issue of time, but process, and the presence of microbes and decaying mulch seems to be the real key. This can be seen in our mulch enriched stalactite machines that grow at 2.5 cm (1") per month as opposed to the evolutionist claims that the average fastest rate is 1mm per year (1/25 in). Bacterial mulch gives a growth rate of 200-300 times the evolutionists' long slow age. They don't do real science; they do pagan philosophy designed to eliminate both a 6 day creation and the Real Creator Christ.

Also, a first for this year was the 'Tites 'n' Mites field trip in the west of the UK. Starting at the Creation Research centre in Oswestry, we looked at the extensive collection of stalactites and



stalagmites from around the world, including several fast-forming examples, such as the 'Tite Pipe' from the Kralovy Vary (Czech Rep) – formed in just months! Attendees also got to see the museum's stalactite machine in action, and explore the processes behind the fast-forming tites. We then travelled to the next village down – Chirk - to travel through its canal tunnel, designed by famed architect, Thomas Telford, around 1794. In just 229 years, stalactites that match the PH of caves

have grown throughout the end of the tunnel that runs under woodland. After lunch, we headed further into Wales to Sygun Copper mines, to see the amazing stalactites that had formed there in less than 100 years, and see just how fast they can grow when the process is right.

MUSEUM REPORT

BIG DEVELOPMENTS in the UK museum project, as we have now been open for over 7 months, and the work is still on-going! We are working on a brand new Living Fossils display, and have been hard at work with graphics and content creation. New to the collection is this guitar fish fossil from the German Jurassic Solnhofen, shown alongside its modern companion - no evolution in a supposed 155 million years! We've also added this



remarkable Priscacara fossil from the Green River Formation, USA (supposedly around 50 million years old) - having recently had its name changed to Cockerellites. Now, from all these fossil names and dates, you may well take away the impression that this is an evolved and now extinct fish - until you see it up next to the modern Banded Sunfish. No change eh? Living fossil for sure, and a great new addition to the collection - experts we've checked with say this is the best fossil example they've seen of this fish - Praise the Lord for great finds!

as Joe & Susie report increased interest from the public, as visitors drop in on Wednesdays and Saturdays. Debates and discussions are frequent, as people are shocked that there are people who don't believe in evolution. NEW WORK EXPERIENCE MINISTRY

as we welcomed Oliver to Creation Research for a week. The program was not just for experience of work, but also to teach some essential research skills and museum curating. We ended up going through much of the collection that had been in storage since the big museum move last year, and ended up finding some real hidden gems! The program also included a trip into North Wales, to the Great Orme, in order to dig some fossils. Living fossils abounded, as well as great evidence for flooding in the Carboniferous limestone. This limestone is found throughout the world, making it a global flood deposit for sure! Pray for this new extension of the ministry as we consider adding internships and work experience to future museum plans.

Research Report

STALACTITE MACHINE developing well, as in 6 months the tites have grown an average of 2.5 cm (1") per month, showing for sure that stalactite and stalagmite formation is all about **PROCESS** and nothing to do with **TIME**! The organic mulch we used as the source of microbes (an essential part of fast tite formation) also gave us an unexpected example of fast fossilisation. A stray woodlouse (pill bug) ended up crawling across the stalagmite that was forming on the tray beneath, before getting stuck in the sticky surface and being completely permineralised – a fast fossil!

GREAT NEW ARCHAEOLOGICAL AND NEANDERTHAL RESEARCH done in the British Channel Islands, including investigating several Neanderthal sites and Neolithic burial grounds throughout the islands. Neanderthals were named after the Neander valley in Germany, which has nothing to do with any evolutionary stage, but is, in fact, named after famed hymn writer Joachim Neander. Why do you call Me good?

A Bible Study with Joseph Hubbard

Key Verses: Mark 10:18

“So Jesus said to him, “Why do you call Me good? No one is good but One, that is, God.””

This was the question that Jesus asked the rich young ruler when he had asked the question, “Good teacher, how shall I inherit eternal life?” Jesus’ response? “There is none good but God.” The implication is simple, unless this rich young ruler was calling Jesus God, there was a problem with his thinking. And Jesus’ rebuke shouldn’t surprise us. If we’d have treated the Bible as a novel and started reading from the beginning, we’d have found out that the last time Jesus had called the world good was at the end of the very first chapter. By the end of the third chapter, we’d have been introduced to the major conflict for the story – sin has entered the world, and mankind is now flawed. By the second half of chapter 5, mankind no longer bears the image of God.

“This is the book of the genealogy of Adam. In the day that God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. He created them male and female, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created. And Adam lived one hundred and thirty years, and begot a son in his own likeness, after his image, and named him Seth. After he begot Seth, the days of Adam were eight hundred years; and he had sons and daughters.” – Genesis 5:1-4

Did you catch the key plot point? Adam’s son, Seth, was not made in the image of God – but the image of his father, Adam. At this point of history, Adam was a sinner, and no longer did he bear the full image of God, but a broken, marred, sinful image. The world had changed from good to bad, and now there was none good but God.

We rejoin Jesus near the climax of this sin-conflict. By this time, the world had gone from good to bad to worse. All have sinned and fallen short of any hope of being declared good by God (Romans 3:23). Some, like Moses (Exodus 32:32), had tried to take the punishment for others’ sins, but being sinners themselves, they could take the punishment of nobody’s sins but their own. But fret not, for a covenant had been made before the foundations of the world had been laid, that the very creator Himself would come, the very Word of God made flesh would come and dwell among us, yet despite His human nature would never sin. When He would subsequently be crucified and killed, the question to be asked is: “Why did He die?” We are told explicitly in scripture that death is the penalty for sin, so if He knew no sin, then why did He die? The answer lies in Corinthians – He became sin for us. He was not paying the penalty for His sin, but for ours. He was doing what nobody other than a good man could do – dying so that we might live.

In a world where we like to think that we’re improving all the time, it is extremely important to get the Biblical perspective of the world – one that has gone from Good to Bad to Worse. But for those of us whom the Lord has called, we are given a promise for the future: Good to Bad to Worse...to GLORY! So praise the LORD that by His grace and power we may one day be called ‘GOOD servant’ and in all that you do, do it for His glory!
